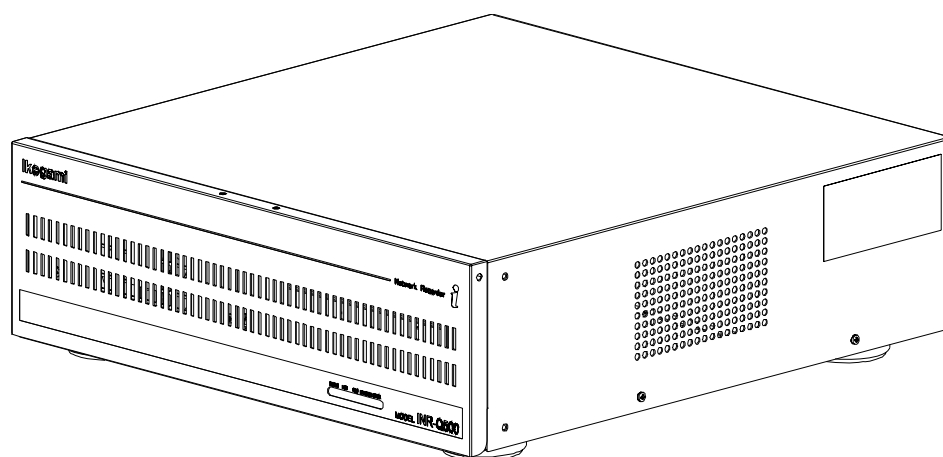

- Browser: Microsoft ® Internet Explorer® 6.0

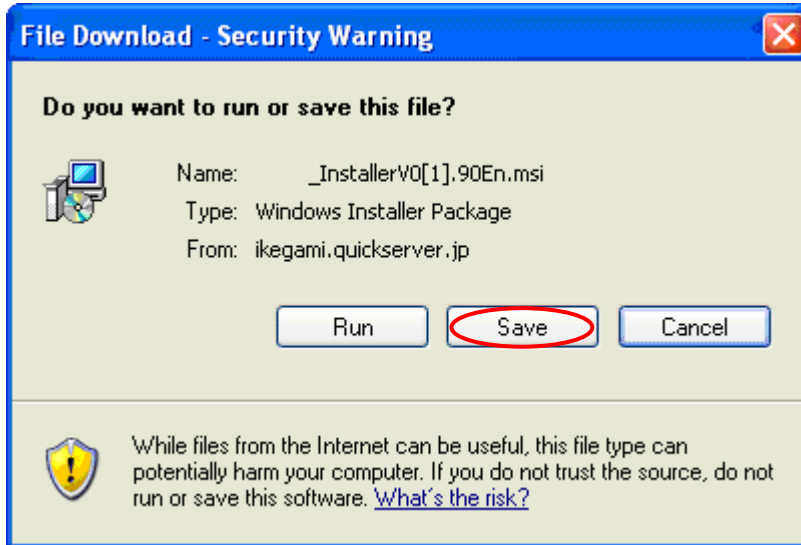

Installation (1)

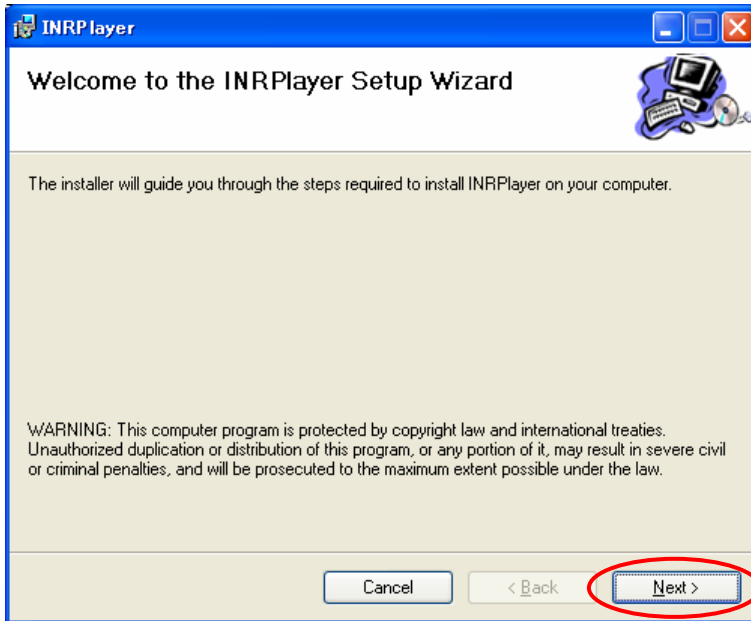

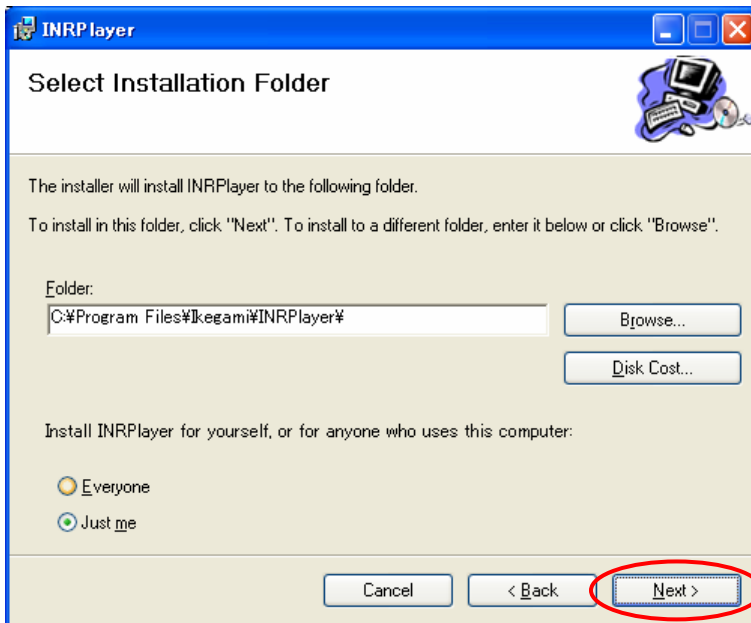
Double click on "INRPlayer_InstallerVx.xxEn.msi" located in the folder which contains the file.

When the Tool Setup Wizard window shown below is displayed, click on the [Next] button.

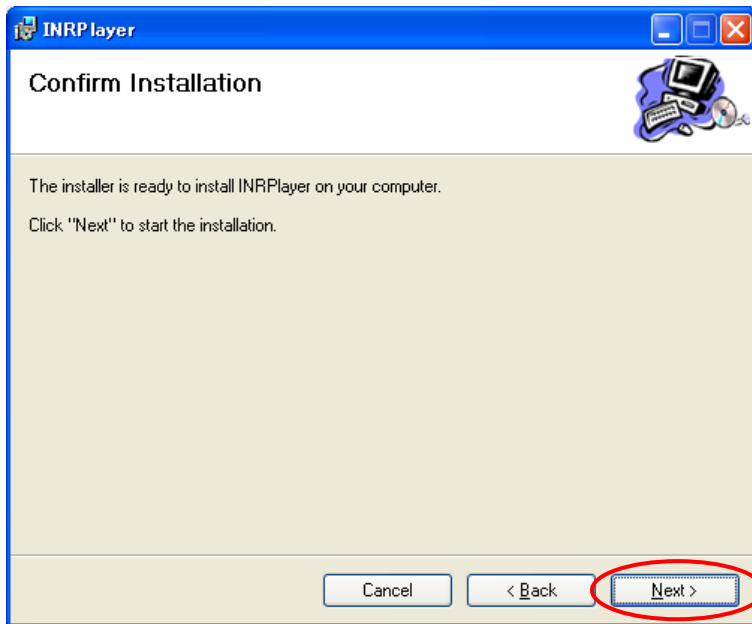


When the Select Installation Folder window shown below is displayed, click on the [Next] button.

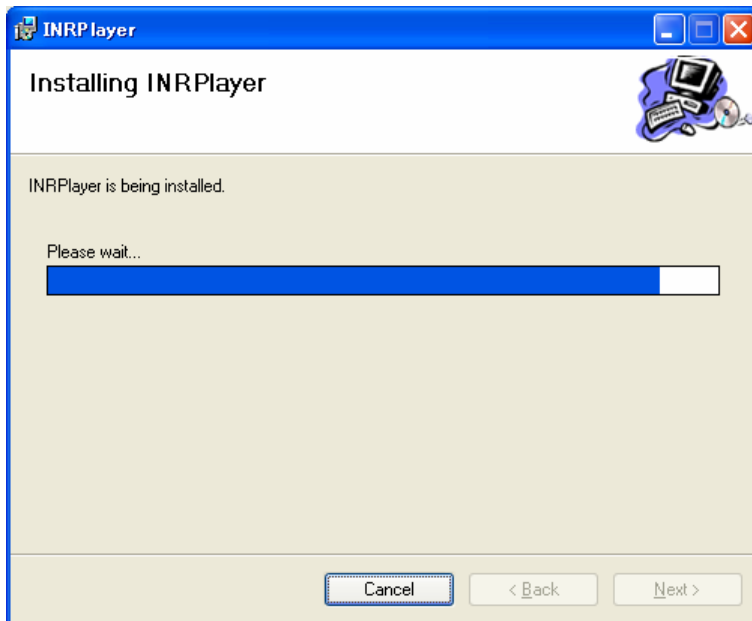


Installation (3)

In the Confirm Installation window shown below, click on the [Next] button.

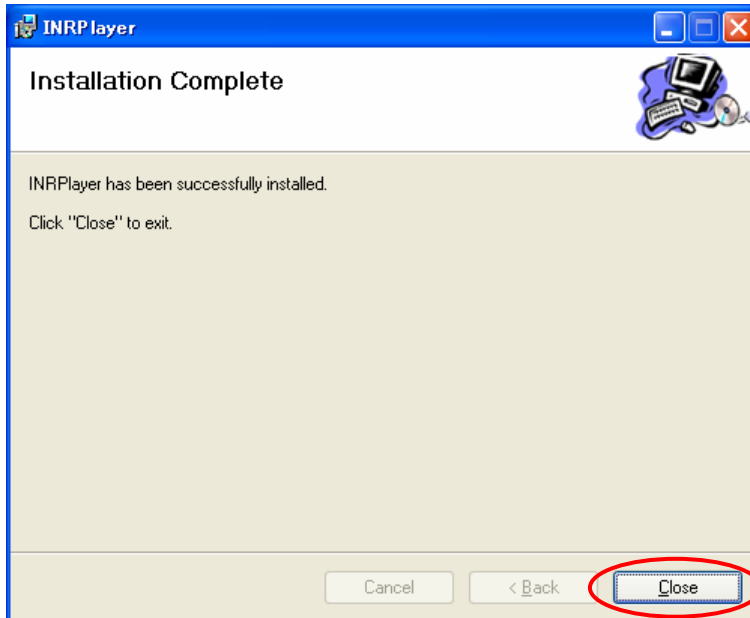


The following window shows the progress of the software installation.

The "INRPlayer" icon will be created on the Windows desktop.

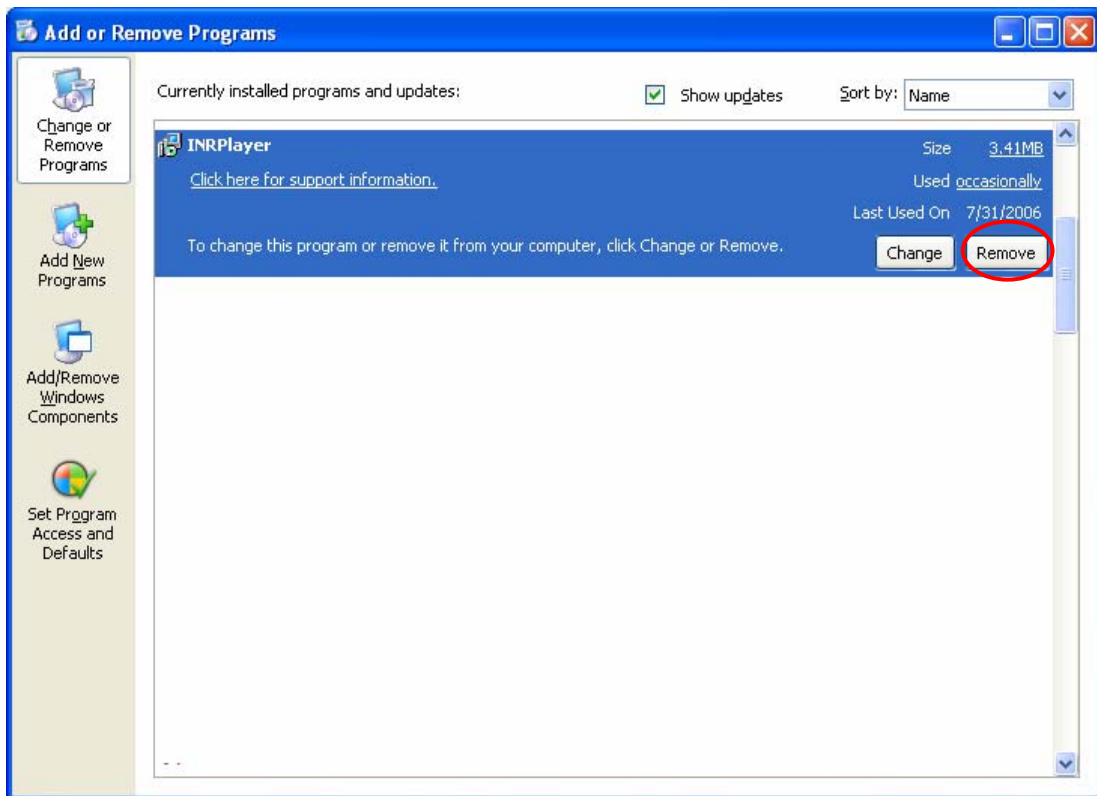


Uninstall instructions

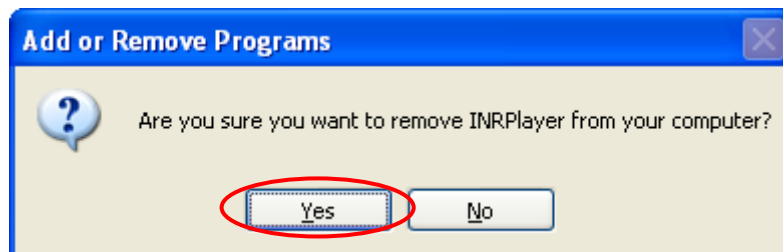
To uninstall the Software, go to [Start] -> [Control Panel] then click on the [Add or Remove Programs].
